

A day in the life of a Super Camps Instructor

7.50 – 8.50 Staff arrive to begin their shift. You must be ready in front of the children by the beginning of your shift so get to site 5 mins early to put your personal gear away and check your timetable/responsibilities for the day

9.20 – 9.30 The Morning Welcome staff meet, register and welcome their crew. One member of staff takes the communal welcome/safety talk before everyone begins their first session. The morning welcome is a fun five minutes which gets the children ready for an action packed day of fun!

10.50 – 11.10 Morning break help and supervise children getting a drink from the water station and a snack from their bag. Once they are fed and watered organise a game or two before break finishes

11.10 – 12.30 Session 3&4

11.10 – 12.30 Session 5&6

11.10 – 12.30 Afternoon break

11.10 – 12.30 Session 7&8

16.20 – 16.30 Afternoon wrap up – end the formal day by awarding colour points and super star of the day certificates to the children

8.00 – 9.20 Children arrive for free time activities – staff are assigned to various roles. The Site Manager will give you a specific role during this time

- car park duty, welcoming parents and children
- assisting with signing children in and getting them settled into an activity
- organise art activity table
- organise free time activities

9.30 – 10.20 Session 1&2 – the Site Manager will have assigned you to activities throughout the day. They may be with different crews and will take advantage of your skills and abilities at the various activities we offer. It's your job to make the activities as safe, fun and exciting as they can be for the children. We call this Supercampify. You don't have to re-invent the wheel however you have to deliver each and every activity to engage and inspire the children to participate and have a great time! Some sessions are 40 mins and some are 80 mins depending on the activity

12.30 – 13.30 Lunch – we split lunch in half for the staff and the children. The first half for the children is non-activity and is for them to eat their lunch. The second half is free time activities. Similarly the staff team will be split into two in order to give everyone a 30 min break. If you are with the children for the first half you will be supervising them eating lunch. If you are with the children for the second half you will be organising free time activities

16.30 – 18.00 – Children are signed out – staff (similarly to the morning sign in) are given various roles during this time. As well as the jobs stated above staff also have to complete the equipment inventory, cleaning and tidying. Staff leave between 17.15 and 18.00
