# ASIAN LANTERNS



## INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Start with a rectangular sheet of paper and turn it landscape
- 2. First you are going to make the handle. To do this measure 1 inch in from the edge at the side of the paper. Draw a line and cut along it. Put this piece to one side.
- 3. Fold the paper in half, lengthwise.
- 4. Measure one inch down from the top and draw a horizontal line across the paper.
- 5. Starting from the folded edge at the bottom, measure 1 inch from the side and make a faint mark.
- 6. Cut a straight line up to the line you have just drawn from the mark you made.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 7. Continue to measure 1 inch along the bottom and cut from the marks to the line at the top.
- 8. Unfold the paper, your slits will now be in the middle. Rub off any marks you made.
- 9. Decorate the top and the bottom edge using the materials you have chosen, or you might like to paint your paper to decorate it.
- 10. To finish your lantern, roll it into a tube shape until your long edges overlap at least ½ an inch. Staple or cello tape the edges together to secure.
- 11. Now you can attach your handle.
