



AZTEC PASTA BLING

INSTRUCTIONS:

Using the paint you need to paint the individual pasta shapes in whichever colours you choose.

Place the pasta to one side (outside if the sun is shining!). You will now need to measure the right amount of string/elastic.

Once the pasta has dried you can thread it onto your string/elastic. You might like to try and make a pattern using the colours.

Remember to leave some of the string/elastic to tie the necklace once you finish threading!

EQUIPMENT:

- Pasta (with holes in the middle)
- Elastic or String
- Paint
- Scissors
- Sandwich Bag

DID YOU KNOW?

It was very common for Emperors to wear necklaces and earrings.

Aztec jewellery was made with a rich variety of materials, and often more than one type of material went into one piece.

Various precious stones were used, such as jade, Quartz, Opal, Moonstone, and Turquoise. These were highly polished when used in Aztec jewellery and ornaments.
