

1. BIG TOP TENT



INSTRUCTIONS:

Paint stripes along $\frac{3}{4}$ of an A4 piece of paper. Place this to one side to dry. This will be the body of your circus tent.

Turn your bowl upside down and draw around this one the piece of paper. Cut out this shape. Repeat this on a piece of card (or paper). The paper circle will be tent top and the cardboard one is the base.

Paint stripes onto the paper circle from the middle to the outside and leave to dry. Once your paper circle is dry cut out a 'slice of pizza' shape from the circle.

You can now put glue on one of the edges and curve this round to make your tent top!

EQUIPMENT:

Tent

- Paint
- A Pencil
- A4 White Paper
- Card (Optional)
- Glue or A Glue Gun (Adult Supervision)
- Scissors
- A cereal bowl (To draw around)

TOP TIP:

Make sure that the bowl you use is going to create a circle that is big enough to be the tent top.

If you have a Glue Gun at home, remember to ask an adult to help with this part.



INSTRUCTIONS:

Take the body of your tent and put glue along one of the edges. Now curve it round to join the ends together.

Put glue on one end of the tent body and secure it onto the cardboard (or paper) base.

Put glue along the top edge of the body of the tent and attach the top. Place to one side to dry.

You can now make your flag using any colours or shapes. Once you have designed this glue it to the top of your stick.

You can now glue this to the top of your tent, or make a small hole and slot it in.

EQUIPMENT:

Flag

Lolly stick or a small stick

Paper

TOP TIP:

When sticking the pieces together count to thirty and hold them together to help secure the glue.
