



Mini Shelters



The Challenge

Camp Wilderness challenges you to make a mini waterproof shelter.

The Rules:

You can only use natural things (apart from string)
i.e. Leafs, sticks, bark, moss etc.

It can only be classed as “waterproof” if it can withstand poring a cup of water over the roof, without getting the inside* wet.

Always wash your hands before and after building your shelter.

*you can use toilet tissue or paper towels.

Equipment

- ☐ Thumb-width sticks
- ☐ Leaf litter
- ☐ Moss
- ☐ String
- ☐ An area where it is safe to make your mini shelter.

Progression

Build another shelter from the video and see which is better at keeping dry.
