



### INSTRUCTIONS:

Give each person a number (1-4), each person will have a role:

- 1- Drawer
- 2- Whisperer
- 3- Drawer (optional)
- 4- Writer

Ask everyone to write down two different 'scenes' on paper, cut them out, fold up and place in a hat.

Person 1 must choose a piece of paper from the hat, but not show anyone. They must then draw the scene (No talking). They must then pass this to Person 2 who must whisper to Person 3 or 4 (depending on how many playing).

Person 3 draws what they hear, or if it is Person 4 they must write what they heard. Does what they have written match the original scene?

### EQUIPMENT:

- Paper
- Pencils

### GENERAL:

This game works best with 3-4 people but can be adapted for less.

Example scenes:

- Children playing basketball
- Two Monkeys in a tree
- A Cow driving a Tractor
  
- When Person 1 or 3 are drawing nobody else must look.
